










Tri-County EMC Operation Roundup Foundation Scholarship Program Guidelines

-  Applicants must live in a household served by Tri-County EMC.
-  Recipient must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program at a U.S. accredited college, university or technical school and have maintained a 2.0 average or better on a 4.0 scale.
-  Priority will be given to non-traditional students. This may include individuals who are working full or part-time who have returned to school.
-  Recipients can not receive more than \$2,000 in a two-year period.
-  The scholarships will be awarded in June and December annually. A total of \$4,000 will be awarded annually. Applications should be submitted by April 15 and October 15.
-  The funds may be used to pay tuition and purchase books. Students may be reimbursed for tuition and books with proper receipts or funds can be paid directly to the school.
-  Applications are judged based on academic success, financial need and community involvement.
-  Applications are scored by an independent panel of judges.
-  Applicants must submit an essay of 500 - 750 words that is a typed autobiographical sketch referencing plans, community service involvement and achievements accomplished and/or awards received.

Application deadlines are April 15 and Oct. 15 of each year. Submit your application to:
